Sea Star: In the middle column, after row 5, there should be 22 stitches (not 24). So you will have 22 stitches to divide evenly onto two needles for the bind-off.

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Spider: Row 1 of Assembly of Cephalothorax. It should be "SI 1, p13 (not "p15"), w&t".

Pattern

Arms (Make 5) In MC, CO 15 sts. Continue working back and forth in rows as follows: Row 1: SI1, P13, K1, Row 2: SI1, K5, SI2-K1-P2SSO, K6-13 sts. Rows 3 & 5: SI1, P11, K1. Row 4: SI1, K12. Row 6: SI1, K4, SI2-K1-P2SSO, K5-11 sts. Rows 7 & 9: SI1, P9, K1. Row 8: SI1, K10. Row 10: SI1, K3, SI2-K1-P2SSO, K4-9 sts. Rows 11 & 13: SI1, P7, K1. Row 12: SI1, K8. Row 14: SI1, K2, SI2-K1-P2SSO, K3-7 sts. Rows 15 & 17: SI1, P5, K1. Row 16: SI1, K6. Row 18: SI1, K1, SI2-K1-P2SSO, K2-5 sts. Rows 19 & 21: SI1, P3, K1. Row 20: SI1, K4. Row 22: SI1, SI2-K1-P2SSO, K1-3 sts. Row 23: SI2-P1-P2SSO-1 st.

Cut yarn, thread through final st and pull tight. Beginning from the base of the arm and ending at the tip, use CC and pick up 12 sts from the selvedge of the arm. You will be picking these sts up kwise from the right side of the work at a rate of 1 st per two rows. Turn the work. Beginning at the tip and ending at the base of the arm, pick up another 12 sts from the other selvedge of the arm. Once again, you will be picking these sts up kwise from the right side of the work at a rate of 1 st per two rows. See **Figure 1** for guidance. You should now have a total of 24 sts.

Continue, working back and forth in rows, as follows:

Row 1 (wrong side): SI1, K7, w&t.

Row 2: P8.

Row 3: SI1, K3, w&t.

Row 4: P4.

Row 5: SI1, K10, P2tog-tbls, P2tog, K10, P1—22 sts.

Row 6: SI1, P5, w&t.

Row 7: K5, P1.

Row 8: SI1, P9, K1.

Divide 22 sts evenly onto two needles. Using the three-needle BO method, BO all sts. Cut yarn, thread through final st and pull tight.

Assembly of Arms

In MC, pick up 8 sts from the CO edge of each of the five arms for a total of 40 sts. See **Figure 2** for guidance.

Join these sts into a round and proceed:

Round 1: Knit.

Round 2: *K6, K2tog, repeat from * to end of round—35 sts.

Round 3: *K5, K2tog, repeat from * to end of round—30 sts.

Round 4: *K4, K2tog, repeat from * to end of round—25 sts.

Round 5: *K3, K2tog, repeat from * to end of round—20 sts.

Round 6: *K2, K2tog, repeat from * to end of round—15 sts.

Round 7: *K1, K2tog, repeat from * to end of round—10 sts.

Round 8: *K2tog, repeat from * to end of round—5 sts.

Cut yarn, thread through final 5 sts and pull tight.

Underside

Turn the work over. Using CC yarn, pick up a total of 70 sts around the open underside of the sea star. Pick up these sts as follows: 6 sts in between each of the arms and 8 sts on the CC selvedge of the underside of each arm. See **Figure 3** for guidance in picking up these sts. Join these 70 sts into a round and continue:

Chelicerae (Make 2)

Work the chelicerae (fangs), as follows. In C3, CO 14 sts. Work in rows as follows:

Row 1: SI1, P5, w&t. Row 2: K4, w&t. Row 3: P6, w&t. Row 4: K8. Now, join the sts in a round and continue: Round 5: Knit. Round 6: K6, SSK, K4, K2tog—12 sts. Round 7: Knit. Round 8: [SSK, K2, K2tog] 2 times—8 sts. Round 9: Knit. Round 10: [SSK, K2tog] 2 times—4 sts. Round 11: Knit. Cut yarn, thread through final 4 sts and pull tight.

Assembly of Cephalothorax

Using C1, pick up sts consecutively as follows: 2 sts from the upper selvedge of two legs (to total 4 sts), 7 sts from the upper selvedge of each chelicerae (to total 14 sts) and 2 sts from the upper selvedge of two legs (to total 4 sts). This will result in a total of 22 sts. See Figure 1 for guidance in picking up these sts.

Continue, working back and forth in rows, as follows: Row 1: SI1, P13, w&t. Row 2: K6, w&t. Row 3: P8, w&t. Row 4: K10, w&t. Row 5: P12, w&t. Row 6: K14, w&t. Row 7: P15, w&t. Row 8: K16, w&t. Row 9: P17, w&t. Row 10: K18, w&t. Row 11: P12, w&t. Rows 12-20: Repeat rows 2-10. Row 21: P19, K1. Row 22: SI1, K21.

Continuing with C1 yarn and a new needle, pick up sts consecutively as follows: 2 sts from the upper selvedge of two legs (to total 4 sts), 14 sts from around the upper CO region of the abdomen, and 2 sts from the upper selvedge of two legs (to total 4 sts). This will result in a total of 22 sts. See **Figure 2** for guidance in picking up this second set of 22 sts.

Join these sts into a round with the original 22 sts, for a total of 44 sts. Knit one round. Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Using the long yarn tail and a tapestry needle, graft (Kitchener st) the sts from the first needle to the sts on the second needle.
